

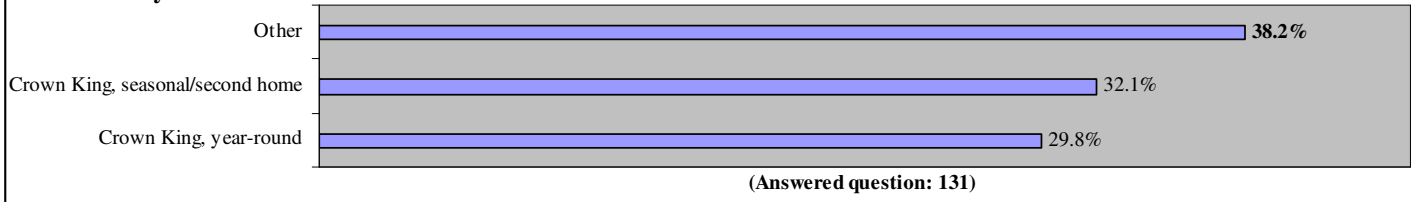

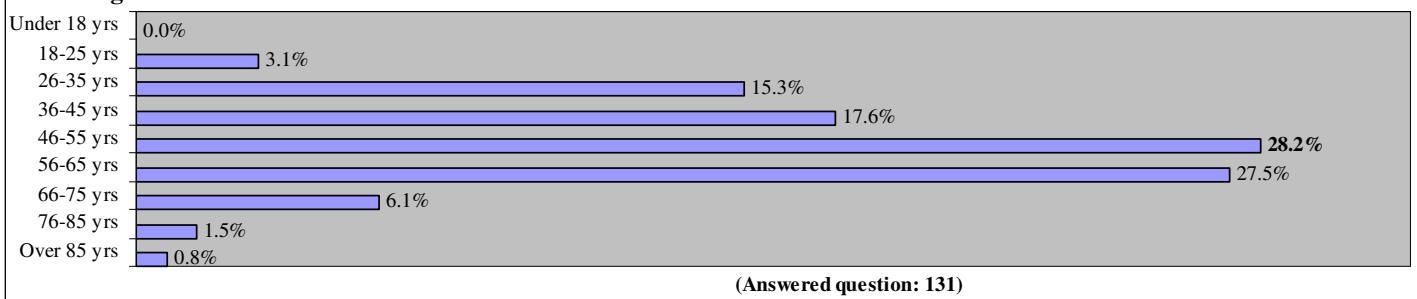
1. Where do you reside?



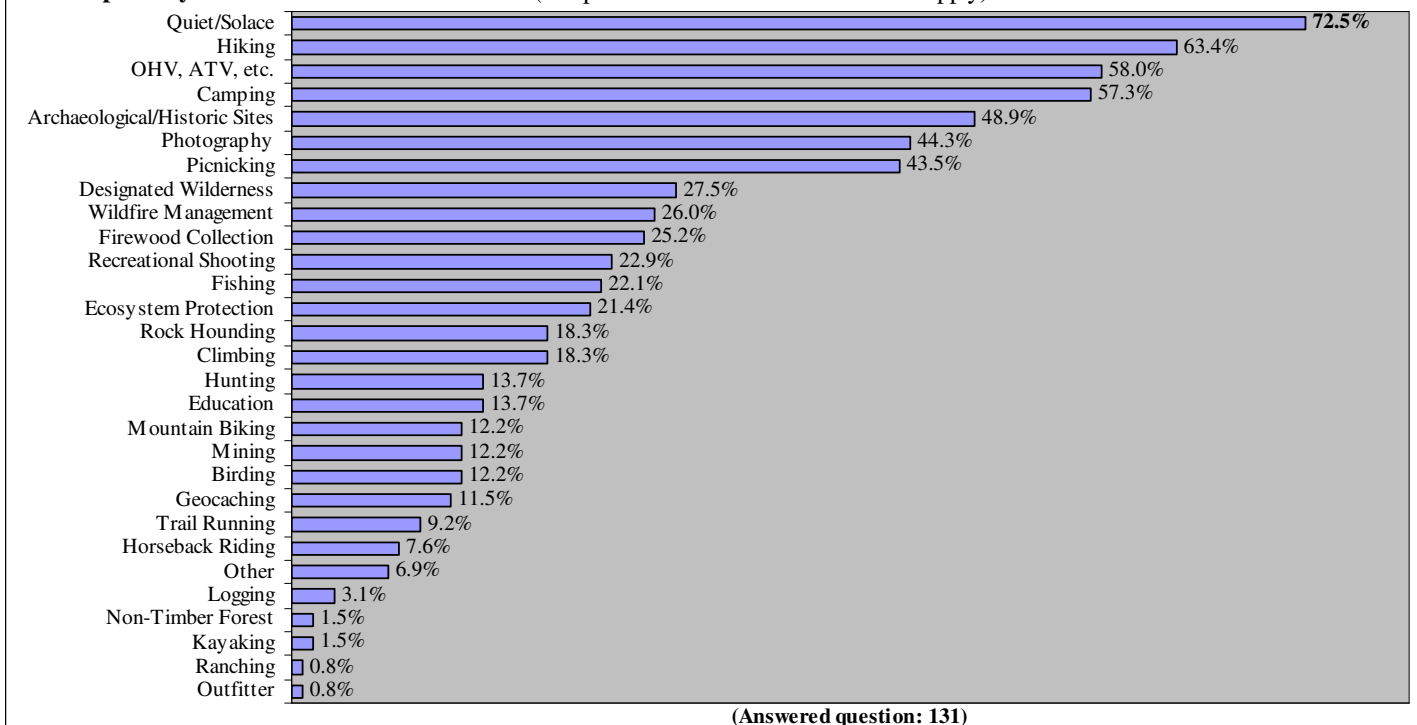
